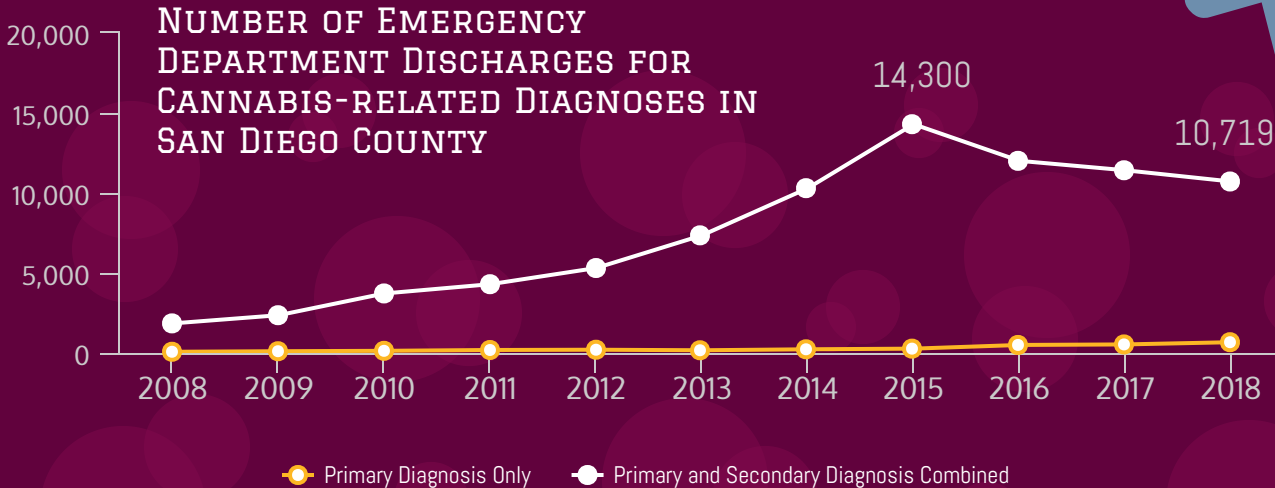

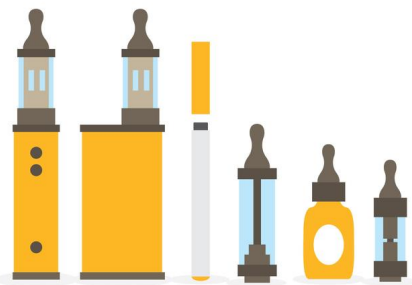

In 2018, more than 29 cannabis related discharges occur per day

There has also been a 43% increase in marijuana exposure cases handled by the California Poison Control Center since the implementation of Prop 64 in 2016.

17% of non-traditional students in San Diego County reported daily use of marijuana in 2019

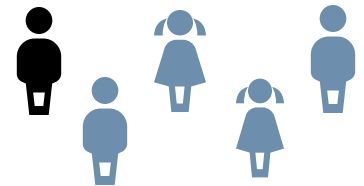
